A dozen Members of the association including Didier Rousseau, sculpture of Marnay, participated in the presentation of the works of Karen Bernard, actress and choreographer and Scott Wixon painter.

On the floor of ACEA, Karen Bernard presented the show call Fleeting Glimpse.

Sitting on a chair with two crossed curtains in the background, the artist did a mime exercise, accompanied by a gymnastic gesture, and a video projection made of interlacing and fantasy curves in a kind of perpetual movement.

She explores the darkest themes of old age and death by remembering the radiant memories of the physical integrity of her youth.

Scott Wixon showed a dozen works between expressionism and abstraction, also made during his stay in Marnay. Scott Wixon's style gives pride of place to movement and undulations. The artist confesses his fascination with color to the point of making it a basic element of his work. In addition, the images he uses give particular relief to his abstract forms. He practices the onirism that he reproduces on the canvas in a continuous creation of the forms born of his image.
